Library Services in Big Park/Village of Oak Creek

Sedona Public Library opened SPL In The Village in December 2005. The opportunity to pick up items ordered through the Yavapai County Network, return items from any library in the Network or use public Internet access computers was welcomed by residents of Big Park/Village of Oak Creek and surrounding areas.

Our original space soon was taxed by the number of items returned here or awaiting pickup by Library patrons and the demand for Internet computers. On Feb. 1, 2011, SPL In The Village opened in larger quarters in Tequa Plaza.



SPL In The Village has no circulating collection of its own. Items can be ordered from any computer with Internet access via the Sedona Public Library site, www.sedonapubliclibrary.org, and picked up in the Village. Unreserved items that are returned In The Village can be checked out. The Library is a WiFi location, and people are welcome to bring their laptops for free wireless access.

SPL In The Village is open 20 hours per week:

- ◆ Tuesday to Friday, 1 to 5 p.m.
- ◆ Saturday, 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Yavapai County, the Sedona Public Library Board of Trustees, Friends of

the Sedona Library and the Association of Village Artists have provided the majority of the funding for SPL In The Village. To keep these convenient services available in the area, ongoing funding is needed to cover operational expenses.

For example, we expect to need additional furnishings, including a heavy-duty bookdrop box. Donated funds also would help cover our operating expenses, equipment and other needs.

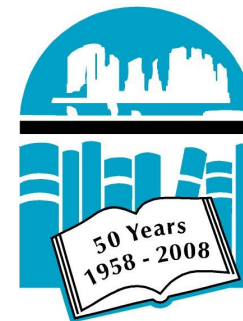
