


*She Persisted: 13 American Women Who Changed the World*


*Wilma Unlimited: How Wilma Rudolph Became the World's Fastest Woman*








This book is an engaging resource about how America's women won the right to vote. (Interest level grade 5 and up)








Learn about the zoologist Jess Keating and how she helped teach the world that sharks needed to be honored and not feared. (Interest level grade 2 and up)
